OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
NUMBER 2 OF 2024
ON
EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN FOSTERING PANCASILA IDEOLOGY
BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

HEAD OF THE AGENCY FOR FOSTERING PANCASILA IDEOLOGY
OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

- Considering : a. that in order to improve understanding, enforcement, and actualization of the values of Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia, it is necessary to organize education and training in Pancasila ideology in accordance with the dynamics of the local, national, and international strategic environment;
- b. that Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 2 of 2020 on Education and Training in Fostering Pancasila Ideology is no longer in line with current legal developments, and therefore it needs to be replaced;
- c. that based on the considerations as referred to in point a and point b, it is necessary to issue a Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology on Education and Training in Fostering Pancasila Ideology;
- Observing : 1. Presidential Regulation Number 7 of 2018 on Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 17);
2. Regulation of the President of the Republic of Indonesia Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2022 Number 86);
3. Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 5 of 2021 on Organization and Work Procedure of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2021 Number 938) as amended by Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 4 of 2023 on Amendment to Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 5 of 2021 on Organization and Work Procedures of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2023 Number 794);

4. Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2022 Number 748) as amended by Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 5 of 2023 on Amendment to Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2023 Number 795);

HAS DECIDED:

To issue : REGULATION OF THE AGENCY FOR FOSTERING PANCASILA IDEOLOGY ON EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN FOSTERING PANCASILA IDEOLOGY.

CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Agency Regulation:

1. Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology (*Badan Pembinaan Ideologi Pancasila*), hereinafter abbreviated as BPIP, means an institution that is under the authority of and responsible to the President.
2. Head of the BPIP, hereinafter referred to as the Head, means an element of BPIP leaders who has duty to lead and is responsible for the implementation of the BPIP's duties and functions.
3. Deputy means the deputy in charge of education and training in fostering Pancasila ideology.
4. Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop (*Pasukan Pengibar Bendera Pusaka*) hereinafter referred to as Paskibraka means the best students who are the nation's cadres assigned to hoist/lower duplicates of the Heirloom Flag at the commemoration ceremony of the Anniversary of the Proclamation of Independence of the Republic of Indonesia and the commemoration ceremony of the Birth of Pancasila at the national/central, provincial, and regency/municipal level.
5. Alumnus of Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop (*Purnapasukan Pengibar Bendera Pusaka*) hereinafter referred to as Purnapaskibraka means Paskibraka who has completed the assignment of hoisting/lowering a duplicate of the Heirloom Flag at the commemoration ceremony of the Anniversary of the Proclamation of Independence of the Republic of Indonesia and the commemoration ceremony of the Birth of Pancasila.
6. Purnapaskibraka Pancasila Ambassadors mean Purnapaskibraka who have been appointed as Pancasila ambassadors by the Head.
7. Fostering Pancasila Ideology (*Pembinaan Ideologi Pancasila*), hereinafter abbreviated as PIP, means all

- activities carried out in a planned, systematic, and integrated manner with the aim of implementing, instilling, and maintaining the values of Pancasila so that they can be upheld and implemented by all elements of the nation in all aspects of the life of society, nation, and state.
8. PIP Education and Training (*Pendidikan dan Pelatihan*), hereinafter referred to as Diklat PIP, means a learning process to improve the character intelligence of the nation based on the values of Pancasila so that it has holistic and complete capabilities covering aspects of knowledge, disposition in the form of attitude and commitment, and actions in the life of society, nation, and state.
 9. PIP Basic Substance means substances that are prepared to understand, elaborate, and serve as the basis for implementing PIP as the state fundamental, a way of life, and state ideology for all Indonesian people in the life of society, nation and state.
 10. Learning Hours mean the units of time required in Diklat PIP.

Article 2

Diklat PIP is conducted based on the principle of *gotong royong* (mutual cooperation) as an effort to realize collaborative work in a dialogical, inspirational, participatory, mutually positive interdependence, and social coordination among interests in the implementation of Diklat PIP.

CHAPTER II

TARGETS, MATERIALS, AND INSTRUCTORS OF DIKLAT PIP

Article 3

The targets of Diklat PIP consist of:

- a. state officers;
- b. members of socio-political organizations;
- c. other community members; and
- d. Purnapaskibraka and Purnapaskibraka Pancasila Ambassadors.

Article 4

- (1) Diklat PIP materials consist of:
 - a. PIP Basic Substances;
 - b. Pancasila general substances; and
 - c. enrichment material.
- (2) The PIP Basic Substances as referred to in section (1) point a is in accordance with the BPIP Regulation governing PIP Basic Substances.
- (3) The Pancasila general substances as referred to in section (1) point b contains the philosophy and science of Pancasila and its implementation in public policy and/or the practice of the life of society, nation, and state.
- (4) The enrichment material as referred to in section (1) point c contains current issues related to PIP and/or nationality that are tailored to the needs and characteristics of the Diklat PIP program's target audience.

Article 5

- (1) Diklat PIP instructors consist of:
 - a. maheswara, who come from the following elements:
 - a. civil services;
 - b. the Defense Force of Indonesia; and/or
 - c. the Indonesian National Police,
 - b. lecturers.
- (2) The Diklat PIP Instructors as referred to in section (1) are appointed by the Head.

Article 6

- (1) The Diklat PIP Instructors as referred to in Article 5 section (1) must be certified by BPIP based on certain qualifications established by BPIP.
- (2) Technical guidelines regarding the implementation of certification for Diklat PIP instructors as referred to in section (1) are established by the Head.

CHAPTER III IMPLEMENTATION OF DIKLAT PIP

Article 7

- (1) BPIP formulates short-term, medium-term, and long-term national Diklat PIP plans.
- (2) The Diklat PIP plans as referred to in section (1) are outlined in the national Diklat PIP blueprint.

Article 8

In the event of state institutions, ministries/agencies, local governments, socio-political organizations, and other community components developing Diklat PIP plans, they must refer to the national Diklat PIP blueprint as referred to in Article 7 section (2).

Article 9

Diklat PIP consists of:

- a. Regular Diklat PIP; and
- b. Special Diklat PIP.

Article 10

- (1) The regular Diklat PIP as referred to in Article 9 point a is conducted to produce role models in the application of Pancasila values in various aspects of the life of society, nation, and state.
- (2) The regular Diklat PIP is conducted for a minimum of 32 (thirty-two) Learning Hours.
- (3) The implementation of regular Diklat PIP is in accordance with the rank or position qualifications of the Diklat PIP participants, including:
 - a. basic or pratama;
 - b. intermediate or madya; and
 - c. advanced.

Article 11

- (1) The Special Diklat PIP as referred to in Article 9 point b is

conducted in the form of PIP strengthening to provide guidance, refreshment, introduction, and reinforcement of policies and understanding of Pancasila values in the life of society, nation, and state.

- (2) The Special Diklat PIP is conducted for a minimum of 16 (sixteen) Learning Hours.

Article 12

- (1) The Diklat PIP as referred to in Article 9 is conducted by BPIP.
- (2) State institutions, ministries/agencies, and local governments may conduct the Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1), after obtaining accreditation from BPIP.
- (3) The implementation of Diklat PIP by state institutions, ministries/agencies, and local governments as referred to in section (2) is coordinated with BPIP.

Article 13

- (1) Accreditation of Diklat PIP organizers as referred to in Article 12 section (2) is carried out to ensure the quality, efficiency, effectiveness, and accountability of Diklat PIP implementation.
- (2) The accreditation of Diklat PIP organizers as referred to in section (1) is granted to state institutions, ministries/agencies, and local governments that meet the assessment standards set by BPIP.

Article 14

- (1) The implementation of Diklat PIP is in accordance with the Diklat PIP Standards and the Diklat PIP Curriculum.
- (2) The Diklat PIP Standards as referred to in section (1) at least consist of:
 - a. national character standards;
 - b. content standards;
 - c. process standards;
 - d. assessment standards;
 - e. human resource standards;
 - f. management standards; and
 - g. facilities and infrastructure standards.
- (3) The Diklat PIP curriculum consists of at least:
 - a. background and objectives;
 - b. curriculum;
 - c. methods;
 - d. media;
 - e. learning resources; and
 - f. assessment.
- (4) The Diklat PIP Standards and Diklat PIP Curriculum are developed based on:
 - a. BPIP policies; and
 - b. the needs and characteristics of the Diklat PIP target audience.
- (5) The Deputy is responsible for developing and refining the Diklat PIP Standards and Diklat PIP Curriculum.

Article 15

- (1) The Diklat PIP is conducted:
 - a. offline;
 - b. online; and/or
 - c. in combination.
- (2) The offline Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1) point a is conducted through face-to-face meetings.
- (3) The online Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1) point b is conducted using the internet.
- (4) The Diklat PIP in combination as referred to in section (1) point c is conducted by combining the implementation of Diklat PIP through offline and online methods in a synchronous and asynchronous manner.

Article 16

Technical guidelines regarding the implementation of Diklat PIP as referred to in Article 10 to Article 15 are established by the Head.

Article 17

- (1) Participants in Diklat PIP who have completed the entire Diklat PIP program are declared as Diklat PIP graduates.
- (2) The Diklat PIP graduates as referred to in section (1) receive a Diklat PIP Completion Certificate.
- (3) Diklat PIP graduates as referred to in section (2) with the best performance receive a certificate of appreciation.
- (4) Participants in the Diklat PIP who are unable to complete the entire Diklat PIP Program receive a Certificate of Participation in the Diklat PIP Program.

Article 18

- (1) The Deputy manages the database of participants and graduates of the Diklat PIP program as referred to in Article 17.
- (2) The management of the Diklat PIP participant database as referred to in section (1) coordinates with the BPIP work unit in charge of data and information technology.

CHAPTER IV

MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF DIKLAT PIP

Article 19

- (1) Monitoring of Diklat PIP is carried out to ensure that the implementation of Diklat PIP is in accordance with the Diklat PIP Standards and the Diklat PIP Curriculum.
- (2) The monitoring of Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1) is carried out by BPIP during the implementation of Diklat PIP.
- (3) The monitoring of Diklat PIP as referred to in section (2) is carried out on:
 - a. Diklat PIP organizers;
 - b. Diklat PIP participants; and
 - c. Diklat PIP instructors.
- (4) Technical guidelines regarding the procedures for conducting monitoring of Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1) are established by the Head.

Article 20

- (1) Evaluation of Diklat PIP is conducted by BPIP to assess the achievement of Diklat PIP objectives.
- (2) The evaluation of the Diklat PIP as referred to in section (1) is conducted after the implementation of the Diklat PIP.
- (3) Technical guidelines regarding the procedures for conducting Diklat PIP evaluations as referred to in section (1) are established by the Head.

CHAPTER V
DIKLAT PIP FUNDING

Article 21

Funding for the implementation of Diklat PIP is sourced from:

- a. State Budget;
- b. Local Budget; and/or
- c. other legitimate and non-binding sources in accordance with the provisions of legislation.

CHAPTER VI
TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

Article 22

At the time this Regulation comes into force:

- a. c Diklat PIP continues to be organized under Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 2 of 2020 on Education and Training in Fostering Pancasila Ideology and Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program as amended by Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 5 of 2023 on Amendment to Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program, until the technical guidelines regarding the implementation of Diklat PIP under this Agency Regulation are established; and
- b. the Diklat PIP organizers that are in the process of accreditation prior to the enforcement of this Agency Regulation continue to be processed under Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 2 of 2020 on Education and Training in Fostering Pancasila Ideology.

CHAPTER VII
CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 23

At the time this Regulation comes into force:

- a. Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 2 of 2020 on Education and Training in Fostering Pancasila Ideology (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2020 Number 900); and

- b. The provisions of Article 64 and Chapter IV of the Annex to Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2022 Number 748) as amended by Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 5 of 2023 on Amendment to Regulation of the Agency for Fostering Pancasila Ideology Number 3 of 2022 on Implementing Regulation of Presidential Regulation Number 51 of 2022 on Heirloom-Flag Hoisting Troop Program (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2023 Number 795),
are repealed and declared ineffective.

Article 24

This Agency Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order that every person may know hereof, it is ordered to promulgate this Agency Regulation by its placement in the State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia.
