REGULATION OF THE NATIONAL CYBER AND CRYPTO AGENCY NUMBER 4 OF 2018

ON

VISION AND MISSIONS OF NATIONAL CYBER AND CRYPTO AGENCYm8

BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

HEAD OF THE NATIONAL CYBER AND CRYPTO AGENCY,

Considering : a. that the National Crypto Agency has transformed into the National Cyber and Crypto Agency;

- b. that in order to actualize good governance in the National Cyber and Crypto Agency in line with the main duty and functions, changes to the organization's vision and missions are required;
- c. that Regulation of Head of the National Crypto Agency Number 4 of 2011 on Vision and Missions of the National Crypto Agency has been irrelevant and, therefore, needs to be renewed;
- d. that based on the considerations in point a, point b, and point c, it is necessary to issue a Regulation of National Cyber and Crypto Agency on Vision and Missions of the National Cyber and Crypto Agency;
- Observing : 1. Presidential Regulation Number 53 of 2017 on National Cyber and Crypto Agency (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 100) as amended by Presidential Regulation Number 133 of 2017 on Amendments to Presidential Regulation Number 53 of 2017 on National Cyber and Crypto Agency (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 277);

- Regulation of National Cyber and Crypto Agency Number 2 of 2018 on Organization and Work Procedures in National Cyber and Crypto Agency (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 197);
- Regulation of National Cyber and Crypto Agency Number 3 of 2018 on Value System in National Cyber and Crypto Agency (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2018 Number 291);

HAS DECIDED:

To issue : REGULATION OF NATIONAL CYBER AND CRYPTO AGENCY ON VISION AND MISSIONS OF NATIONAL CYBER AND CRYPTO AGENCY.

Article 1

Vision of the National Cyber and Crypto Agency is to be a trustworthy institution in preserving the National Cybersecurity and Crypto by synergizing stakeholders in order to take part in attaining the national security and promoting the national economic growth.

Article 2

The vision to be a trustworthy institution as referred to in Article 1 means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency becomes an institution upholding the values of Professionalism, Integrity, and Technology Adaptability as well as Trustworthiness in attaining the National Cybersecurity and Crypto.

Article 3

The vision to synergize stakeholders as referred to in Article 1 means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency utilize, develop, and consolidate all elements related to the National Cybersecurity and Crypto.

Article 4

The vision to take part in attaining national security as referred to in Article 1 means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency takes part in creating secured cyber condition.

Article 5

The vision to promote national economic growth as referred to in Article 1 means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency plays active roles in organizing secure, comfortable, and trustworthy digital economy.

Article 6

In order to realize the vision as referred to in Article 1 the National Cyber and Crypto Agency has the following missions:

- to ensure information security in the government sector, national critical information infrastructures, and digital economy in attaining national security and promoting national economic growth;
- b. to develop and to apply comprehensive cybersecurity and crypto governance;
- c. to develop independence cybersecurity and crypto technology by encouraging the growth of domestic industries in the sector of cybersecurity and crypto;
- d. to develop, to coordinate, to collaborate, and to operate identification, detection, and mitigation, crisis management, response, and recovery system from any threat, incident and/or cyber and crypto attacks;
- e. to develop cybersecurity culture as internalized cultural values order by promoting safe and comfortable usage of internet culture for every Indonesian citizen; and
- f. to provide and to optimize cybersecurity and crypto resources through sustainable learning processes and quality improvement supported by transparent and accountable office management.

Article 7

(1) The mission to ensure information security in the government sector, national critical information infrastructures, and digital economy in attaining national security and promoting national economic growth as referred to in Article 6 point a means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency develops, performs, and evaluates technical policies of information security in the government sector, national critical information infrastructures, and digital economy while developing partnerships with stakeholders in the national and international scopes in order to attain national security and to promote national economic growth.

- (2) The mission to develop and to apply comprehensive cybersecurity and crypto governance as referred to in Article 6 point b means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency develops, implements, and controls policies and standards of cybersecurity and crypto, frameworks for information sharing and collaboration, law enforcement support, and effective and comprehensive cyber and/or crypto incidents response action plans in Indonesia.
- (3) The mission to develop independence cybersecurity and crypto technology by encouraging the growth of domestic industries in the sector of cybersecurity and crypto as referred to in Article 6 point c means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency creates and develops cybersecurity and crypto technologies independently and supports domestic industries development in cybersecurity and crypto technologies.
- (4) The mission to develop, to coordinate, to collaborate, and to operate identification, detection, and mitigation, crisis management, response, and recovery system from any threat, incident, and/or cyber and crypto attacks as referred to in Article 6 point d means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency prepares, organizes, coordinates, collaborates, actuates, controls, evaluates, and reports identification, detection, mitigation, crisis management, response, and recovery system from any threat, incident and/or cyber and crypto attacks while supports cyber crimes handling in Indonesia through investigation supports, digital forensic, crypto analyses, and content filtering.
- (5) The mission to develop cybersecurity culture as internalized cultural values order by promoting safe and comfortable

usage of internet for every Indonesian citizen as referred to in Article 6 point e means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency provides literacy and education of cybersecurity cultures in order to build cybersecurity awareness and cybersecurity cultures as the value system for every citizen to create safe and comfortable internet ecosystem.

(6) The mission to provide and to optimize cybersecurity and crypto resources through sustainable learning processes and quality improvement supported by transparent and accountable office management as referred to in Article 6 point f means that the National Cyber and Crypto Agency provides and uses cybersecurity and crypto resources optimally including human resources, facilities and infrastructures, and cybersecurity and crypto technologies through learning and improvement processes supported by good, transparent, and accountable office management.

Article 8

At the time this Agency Regulation comes into force, Regulation of Head of the National Crypto Agency Number 4 of 2011 on Vision and Missions of the National Crypto Agency (the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2011 Number 847) is repealed and declared ineffective.

Article 9

This Agency Regulation comes into force on the date of promulgation.

In order that every person may know hereof, it is ordered to promulgate this Agency Regulation by its placement in State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia.
