ON

PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF BENDEGA

BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

THE MAYOR OF DENPASAR,

Considering

that in order to implement the provisions of Article 4 of the Regulation of the Province of Bali Number 11 of 2017 on *Bendega*, it is necessary to establish a Regional Regulation on Protection and Preservation of *Bendega*.

Observing

- 1. Article 18 section (6) of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia;
- 2. Law Number 1 of 1992 on Establishment of the Municipality of Level II of Denpasar (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 1992 Number 9, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3465);
- 3. Law Number 31 of 2004 on Fisheries (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2004 Number 118, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4433) as amended by Law Number 45 of 2009 on Amendment to Law Number 31 of 2004 on Fisheries (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2009 Number 154, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5073);
- 4. : REGIONAL REGULATION ON PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF BENDEGA.

CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

In this Regional Regulation:

1. Region means the City of Denpasar.

- 2. Local Government means the Municipal Government of Denpasar.
- 3. Mayor means the Mayor of Denpasar.
- 4. The Office of Culture and the Office of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries, hereinafter referred to as the Offices, means local apparatuses that carry out affairs in the field of culture as well as local apparatuses that carry out affairs in the field of maritime and fisheries.
- 5. Bendega means a Traditional Institution in the field of maritime and fisheries affairs for indigenous peoples in Bali who exist in the areas of coastal, economic, social, cultural and religious in historically continued to grow and develop in accordance with culture and local wisdom of Bali.
- 6. *Krama Bendega* means a person who carries out economic, social, cultural and religious activities on the coast which is a traditional fishing right that has been carried out for generations in accordance with the culture and local wisdom of Bali.
- 7. Prajuru Bendega means the Manager of Bendega.
- 8. Awig-awig Bendega, hereinafter referred to as awig-awig, means customary norms written down and used as guidelines for governing Bendega.
- 9. Tri Hita Karana means the philosophy of life of the people of Bali which contains three elements that build a balanced and harmonious relationship between humans and God, humans and humans, and humans and their environment which are a source of prosperity, peace, happiness for human life.
- 10. Palemahan Bendega, hereinafter referred to as Palemahan, means a place for carrying out economic, social, cultural and religious activities for Bendega.
- 11. Pawongan Bendega, hereinafter referred to as Pawongan, means the relationship between Bendega krama in carrying out social, cultural and religious economic activities.
- 12. Parhyangan Bendega, hereinafter referred to as Parhyangan, means a sacred place for krama Bendega in dealing with Ida Sang Hyang Widhi Wasa.
- 13. Local wisdom means the implementation of *Bendega* protection and empowerment by taking into account social, economic, cultural and religious characteristics as well as the noble values that apply in the way of life of the *Bendega* people.
- 14. Bendega protection, hereinafter referred to as protection, means a systematic and integrated effort made to preserve Bendega.
- 15. Preservation means an effort to preseve and maintain the cultural values of the people of Bali, especially the values of ethics, morals and civilization which are the core of the customs and traditions of the people of Bali so that their existence is maintained and continues.
- 16. Bendega empowerment means all efforts to increase the ability of Bendega to carry out business in Bendega weakened areas based on local wisdom.
- 17. Utilization of *Bendega* means an effort to use the coastal area/weakening of *Bendega* for economic, social, cultural and religious activities.
- 18. Partnership means business cooperation between small businesses, medium businesses and/or large businesses accompanied by coaching and development by medium businesses and/or large businesses with due observance of the principles of

mutual need, mutual strengthening and mutual benefit.

Article 2

The scope of Protection and Preservation of Bendega includes:

- a. Bendega Protection;
- b. Bendega Preservation;
- c. Development of Supervision and Evaluation; and
- d. Funding.

Article 3

- (1) The Local Government is obligated to protect and preserve *Bendega*.
- (2) The Protection and Preservation of *Bendega* are carried out by the Offices.

CHAPTER II BENDEGA PROTECTION

Part One General

Article 4

- (1) Bendega protection as referred to in Article 2 section (1) is carried out by identifying, verifying and determining the Bendega Group.
- (2) *Provisions* regarding the identification, verification and determination of the *Bendega* Group as referred to in section (1) are further regulated in a Mayor Regulation.

Article 5

The local government is obligated to protect *Parhyangan*, *Pawongan* and *Palemahan*.

Part Two Position and Function of *Bendega*

Article 6

The position of *Bendega* as a Traditional Institution protects coastal communities in the field of fisheries and marine affairs.

Article 7

The functions of Bendega include:

- a. assisting the government in increasing development in the field of maritime affairs and fisheries;
- b. implementing and preserving local wisdom in the development of maritime and fisheries affairs;
- c. establishing awig-awig based on Tri Hita Karana.
- d. preserving, maintaining, developing, managinge and utilizinge the sea area and coastal area;
- e. developing the abilities of krama Bendega to increase

- productivity, income and welfare of krama Bendega;
- f. maintaining the preservation of deep sea and coastal areas for sustainable marine and fishery development; and
- g. maintaining the preservation of *parhyangan*, *pawongan* and *pelemahan* in coastal areas.

Part Three Protection Procedures

Article 8

The procedures of protection of Bendega:

- a. Planning; and
- b. Implementation of Protection.

Article 9

- (1) Planning as referred to in Article 8 point a is carried out in a systematic, integrated, comprehensive, transparent and accountable manner.
- (2) Planning as referred to in section (1) must be carried out based on:
 - a. carrying capacity of natural resources and coastal environment;
 - b. fish resource potential;
 - c. land and water potential;
 - d. spatial plans;
 - e. coastal area zoning plan;
 - f. sea area zoning plan;
 - g. development of science and technology;
 - h. the need for facilities and infrastructure;
 - technical and economic feasibility as well as suitability with institutions and local culture; and
 - i. economic growth rate.

Article 10

- (1) The Implementation of Protection as referred to in Article 8 point b includes:
 - a. making policies that support institutions of Bendega;
 - b. provision of fishery business infrastructure;
 - c. ease of obtaining fishery business facilities;
 - d. fishing risk guarantee;
 - e. eliminating high-cost economic practices;
 - f. guarantee of security and safety;
 - g. facilitation and legal assistance.
 - h. education and training;
 - i. counseling and assistance;
 - j. provide financing and capital;
 - k. business partnership;
 - 1. ease of access to science, technology and information;
 - m. institutional strengthening;
 - n. boat Mooring arrangement (jukung); and
 - o. tourism activities.
- (2) Further provisions regarding the arrangement of boat moorings (jukung) as referred to in section (1) point n and tourism activities as referred to in section (1) point o are regulated in a Mayor Regulation.
- (3) The fishing risk guarantee as referred to in section (1) point d is given to *Bendega* who do not yet have insurance.
- (4) Further provisions regarding the provision of fishing risk guarantees as referred to in section (3) are regulated in a Mayor Regulation.

Part Four Prajuru

Article 11

- (1) Bendega led by Prajuru Bendega.
- (2) The selection and composition of *Prajuru Bendega* are in accordance with *awig-awig*.

Part Five Awig-awig

Article 12

- (1) Every Bendega must have an awig-awig.
- (2) The basis for forming *awig-awig* as referred to in section (1) includes:
 - a. Pancasila;
 - b. The 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia;
 - c. Tri Hita Karana; and
 - d. Applicable customs and local wisdom;
- (3) Awig-awig as referred to in section (1) contains local wisdom values and conforms to the awig-awig of Desa Adat.
- (4) The Local Government must provide assistance in making *awig-awig* as referred to in section (1).

Article 13

- (1) Awig-awig made and approved by krama Bendega through paruman.
- (2) Awig-awig as referred to in section (1) is registered at the Local Government.

CHAPTER III BENDEGA PRESERVATION

Part One General

Article 14

Bendega preservation must involve individuals, communities, Desa Adat (Balinese Adat Village) and business world.

Article 15

- (1) The Local Government facilitates the implementation of *Bendega* Preservation.
- (2) The implementation of *Bendega* Preservation as referred to in section (1) is in the form of development and utilization.
- (3) The development and utilization of *Bendega* Preservation as referred to in section (2) is carried out in the *Parhyangan*, *Pawongan* and *Palemahan* fields.

Part Three Parhyangan, Pawongan and Palemahan

Article 16

Preservation in the field of Parhyangan includes:

- a. preservation of Segara Temple in coastal areas; and
- b. sustainably maintain the Segara Temple.

Article 17

- (1) Preservation in the field of *Pawongan* includes:
 - a. working relationship with Government institutions;
 - b. working relationship between krama Bendega;
 - c. working relationship with Desa Adat;
 - d. working relationship with the business world; and
 - e. other social institutions.
- (2) The working relationship with the Government Institution as referred to in section (1) point a can be in the form of a working relationship with the Meteorology, Climatology and Geophysics Agency and/or other Government Institutions.
- (3) The working relationship as referred to in section (1) is coordinative, consultative and partnership.

CHAPTER V GUIDANCE, SUPERVISION AND EVALUATION

Article 18

- (1) The Local Government carries out guidance, supervision and evaluation of *Bendega*.
- (2) In terms of carrying out guidance, supervision and evaluation as referred to in section (1) it can involve the participation of the community, Desa Adat, the business world and other groups.
- (3) Guidance, supervision and evaluation as referred to in section (1) are further regulated in a Mayor Regulation.

CHAPTER VI FUNDING

Article 19

Funding for Protection and Empowerment of *Bendega* activities comes from:

- a. local budget; and
- b. other legal sources of funds in accordance with the provisions of the legislation.

CHAPTER VII CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 20

This Regional Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order that every person may knows hereof, it is ordered to promulgate this Regional Regulation by its placement in the Regional Gazette of the Municipality of Denpasar.

BENDEGA PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION

I. GENERAL

The elaboration of the concept of a welfare state in the form of recognition in the form of *Bendega* Protection and Preservation. Protection and Preservation of *Bendega* is urgently needed in the context of preserving local wisdom and traditional Balinese culture as mandated by Pancasila and the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia. *Bendega* is a traditional institution in the field of maritime affairs and fisheries located in coastal areas that have religious social characteristics that are historically continues to grow and develop in accordance with Balinese culture and local wisdom. Protecting and Preserving *Bendega* is also described in Empowerment. *Bendega* whose function is to build and manage coastal areas that are directed to increase the welfare of the community as much as possible. The form of management of coastal areas related to religious, economic and social activities certainly cannot be separated from the existence of coastal communities.

The existence of *Bendega* in the Municipality of Denpasar so far has contributed in the form of development within the scope of *Palemahan*, *Pawongan* and *Parhyangan*. Protection and Preservation of *Bendega* as a traditional institution engaged in economic, social, cultural and religious affairs based on *Tri Hita Karana*. *Bendega* which is part of Balinese traditional culture plays a role and functions to improve the welfare of Krama *Bendega*, thus *Bendega* needs to be recognized and respected for its existence and traditional rights. Recognition and protection including *Bendega* Protection and Preservation must be based on the philosophy of *Tri Hita Karana* and rooted in the teachings of Hinduism in Bali.

In providing a clear regulatory direction, related to the Protection and Preservation of *Bendega*, it needs to be regulated in the form of a Regional Regulation of the Municipality of Denpasar. Based on these considerations, it is very necessary to establish a Regional Regulation on the Protection and Preservation of *Bendega*.
