# REGULATION OF MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA NUMBER PM 57 OF 2017 ON THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION OF MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION NUMBER KM 17 OF 2009 ON CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY REGULATIONS PART 145 AMENDMENT 3 ON APPROVED MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS

### BY THE BLESSINGS OF ALMIGHTY GOD

#### MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

- Considering : a. that the provisions on approved maintenance organizations has been regulated in the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 3 Amendment 145 on Approved Maintenance Organizations as amended by the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number PM 164 of 2015 on Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 3 Amendment 145 on Approved Maintenance Organizations;
  - b. that it is necessary to adjust towards the provision of validity and extension of certificate period of the approved maintenance organization located in the territory of the Republic of Indonesia in order to compete better with the foreign approved maintenance organization located outside the Republic of Indonesia, as well as promoting the airline industry in Indonesia;

- c. that it is necessary to add a provision on the sources of aeronautical product and the recognition of certificates of the approved maintenance organization published by civil aviation authority on the approved maintenance organization outside the territory of the Republic of Indonesia;
- d. that based on the considerations as referred to in point a, point b, and point c, it is necessary to establish Regulation of Minister of Transportation on the Second Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 145 Amendment 3 on Approved Maintenance Organizations;
- Observing : 1. Law of the Republic of Indonesia Number 1 of 2009 Aviation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2009 Number 1, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4956);
  - Presidential Regulation Number 7 of 2015 on Organization of the State Ministries (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 number 8);
  - Presidential Regulation Number 40 of 2015 on Ministry of Transportation (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 75);
  - 4. Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 145 Amendment 3 on Approved Maintenance Organizations as amended by Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number PM 164 of 2015 on Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 3 Amendment 145 on Approved Maintenance Organizations (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 1595);
  - 5. Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number PM 189 of 2015 on Organization and Management of the Ministry of Transportation (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 1844) as amended several times, last by the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation

Number PM 44 of 2017 on the Second Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number PM 189 of 2015 on the Organization and Management of the Ministry of Transportation (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2017 Number 816);

#### HAS DECIDED:

To Issue

: REGULATION OF MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION ON THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATION OF MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION NUMBER KM 17 OF 2009 ON CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY REGULATIONS PART 145 AMENDMENT 3 ON APPROVED MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.

#### Article I

Some provisions in Regulation of the Minister of Transportation KM Number 17 of 2009 on Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 145 Amendment 3 on Approved Maintenance Organizations as amended by Regulation of the Minister of Transportation Number PM 164 of 2015 on Amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Transportation KM Number 17 of 2009 Civil Aviation Safety Regulations Part 145 on Amendment 3 on Approved Maintenance Organizations (State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia of 2015 Number 1595) is amended as follows:

1. The provision of Article 3 is amended, so that it reads as follows:

### Article 3

At the time when this Ministerial Regulation comes into force then:

- a. Decree of the Minister of Transportation Number KM
  27 of 2003 on Certification and Operating
  Requirements for Aeronautical Products Distributor;
- b. Decree of the Minister of Transportation Number KM 40 of 2004 on Approved Maintenance Organizations;
   repealed and declared ineffective.

2. Annex section 145.0 Subpart A is amended, so that it reads as follows:

145.0 Regulatory Reference

This Civil Aviation Safety Regulation (CASR) Part 145 for Approved Maintenance Organization sets forth the implementing rules as required by Article 51 of Aviation Act Number 1 Year 2009.

- 3. Annex section 145.55 Subpart B is amended, so that it reads as follows:
  - 145.55 Duration and Renewal of Certificate
    - (a) A certificate or rating issued to:
      - (1) The AMO located outside the Republic of Indonesia shall remain in force for such period as determined by the DGCA but shall not exceed 2 (two) years from the date of issue, unless the AMO surrenders the certificate or the DGCA suspends or revokes it.
      - (2) The AMO located outside the Republic of Indonesia shall remain in force for such period as determined by the DGCA (Directorate General of Civil Aviation) but shall not exceed 2 (two) years from the date of issue, unless the AMO surrenders the certificate or the DGCA suspends or revokes it.
    - (b) The DGCA may need to issue temporary extension validity up to 90 days due to unusual circumstances.
    - (c) A certificated AMO that applies for a renewal of its AMO certificate must:
      - submit its request for renewal no later than 30 days before the AMO's current certificate expires. If a request for renewal is not made within this period, the AMO must

follow the application procedures in section 145.51;

- (2) send its request for renewal to the DGCA;
- (3) submit to DGCA a maintenance service provides to Indonesian costumer within years of reports.
- (d) The holder of an expired, surrendered, suspended, or revoked certificate must return it to the DGCA.
- 4. Annex is added by section 145.111 after section 145.109 on Subpart C which reads as follows:
  - 145.111 Sources of aeronautical product
    - (a) The holder of an AMO Certificate must have the system to obtain the aeronautical products from:
      - A manufacturer of aeronautical products;
      - (2) A manufacturer who produces, identifies and certifies standard parts and materials which conform to established industrial, national or international standards, and which are referenced in approved design data;
      - (3) An organization approved either by DGCA, or Foreign Civil Aviation Authority under subpart F of this part, to perform maintenance on aeronautical products and who is authorized to certify such products as serviceable and in a condition for safe operation;
      - (4) A supplier who provides original certification of product conformity to approved design data for supplies acquired from authorized sources.

- (b) The holder of an AMO Certificate must ensure that the source of aeronautical products has the organization, facilities, equipment and the personnel necessary to comply with the policies, responsibilities, methods and procedures established in his product quality control system.
- 5. Annex added Subpart F which reads as follows:
  - SUBPART F –RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN AMO OUTSIDE INDONESIA TERRITORY
  - 145.231 Applicability

This subpart describes how to obtain a recognized of the foreign Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) certificate.

145.233 Recognition Requirements

DGCA may, upon application, issue a recognized of the foreign Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) certificate issued by an ICAO Contracting State provided the applicant:

- (a) complies with the requirements of this part;
- (b) has an Approved Maintenance
  Organization (AMO) Certificate issued by
  the origin Civil Aviation Authority;
- (c) has a letter of intent from the Indonesian costumers requesting maintenance service.

145.235 Scope and Limitation

DGCA may accept, in whole or in part, a recognized of the foreign Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) certificate issued by the origin Civil Aviation Authority within the scope of capability of organization.

145.237 Recognition Certificate

Within 30 working days after completing the application package, the DGCA will issue the recognition certificate to the foreign Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) which meets the requirements as prescribe in this part.

## Article II

This Ministerial Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order that every person may know hereof, it is ordered to promulgate this Ministerial Regulation by its placement in the State Bulletin of the Republic of Indonesia.
